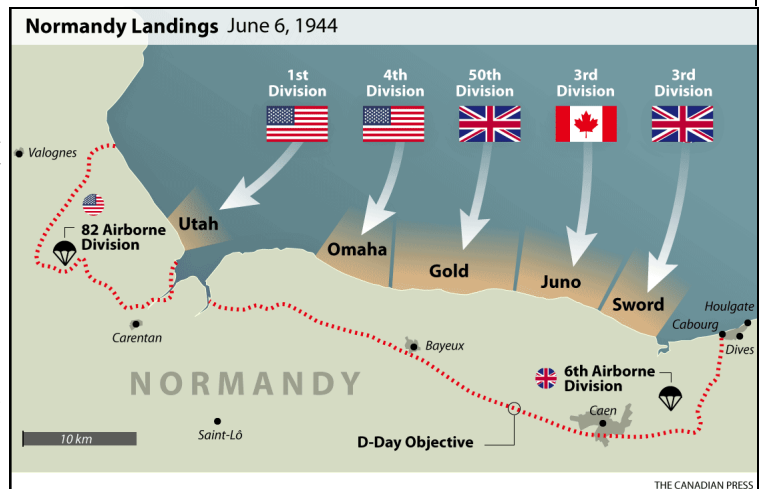

D-DAY—82ND ANNIVERSARY JUNE 6

In the early morning of June 6, 1944, 156,000 American, British, and Canadian forces landed on 50 beaches along a 50-mile stretch in the Normandy region of France. These forces were to defeat the German forces and liberate France.

Years of planning cumulated on that morning; weeks of drills in darkness to try to avoid capture and death from the enemy, and months of Allied bombers bombarding the coast and south to destroy transportation networks and disrupt Germany's army. From the boats, thousands of Allied troops jump, swim, run, crawl to the beaches to get to the protection of the cliffs. Utah, Omaha, Gold, Juno, Sword beaches—200 yards of sand in some cases to reach natural protection. All while carrying 80 pounds or more of equipment, while still soaking wet. This was Operation Neptune; "D-Day"; The Battle of Normandy—the assault phase of the umbrella Operation Overlord. The assault lasted until June 30th when the Allied forces finally were able to establish a secure foothold in Normandy. It wasn't until August 19th, however, that forces were able to cross the River Seine.



Through all these months, over 2 million troops from Allied nations were involved—from Australia, Belgium, France, Czechoslovakia, Greece, New Zealand, Netherlands, Norway, Poland, Canada, United States, and United Kingdom—with over one million crossing the English Channel to Normandy.

It is estimated that there were over 225,000 Allied casualties, 200,000 German troops killed or wounded, along with over 200,000 German troops captured and sent to prisoner-of-war camps—although exact figures from either side are hard to determine.

On this 82nd Anniversary, pause to remember the sacrifices these soldiers made to ensure freedom from Soviet and German forces.

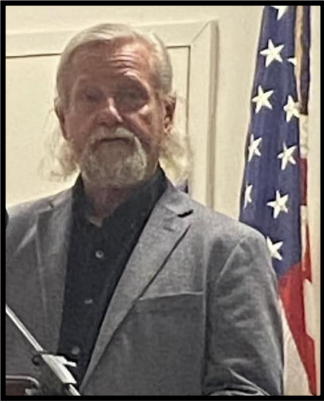

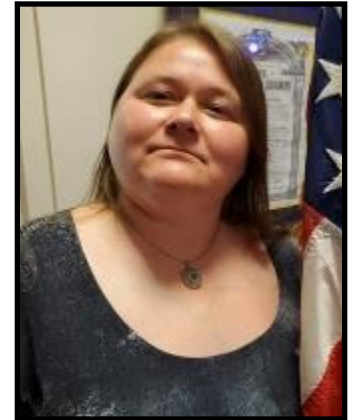

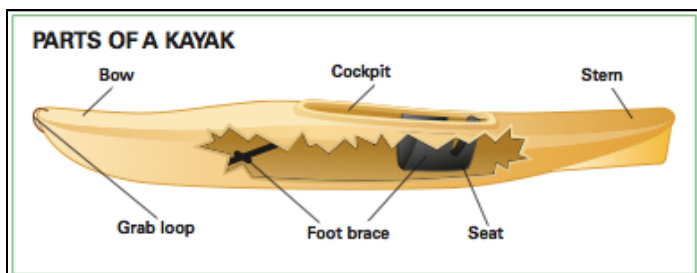
Troop Happenings

- Ticket sales will close at 8PM on Wednesday and the drawing will be at 8:15PM. If the ticket holder will NOT be present, they may wish to put a number on the back of their ticket which would be used to pick their card for the drawing.
- The holder of the winning ticket will be awarded as follows: JOKER - \$50.00 ACE OR FACED CARDS \$25.00- \$5 for all other cards.
- If the Queen is picked, the holder of the winning ticket will win ALL of the sixty percent (60%). **You DO not have to be present WIN.**
- There will be no other prizes awarded.
- The new amount will be posted on the Queen of Hearts board.
- Once the “Queen of Hearts” is selected, the board will no longer be in play and will be placed in storage with the attached winning tickets for a period of three (3) years. A new board will be placed into play.

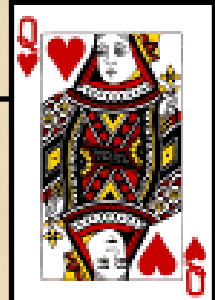
