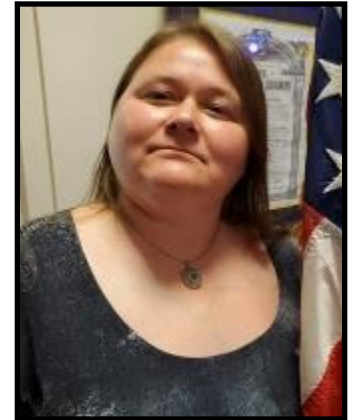

As a reminder, these are the eligibility requirements:

All male descendants adopted sons, stepsons, and grandsons of members of The American Legion, and such **male descendants of veterans who died in service** during the period of April 6, 1917, through November 11, 1918, or any time from December 7, 1941, to date, who served honorably, as set forth in Article IV, Section 1, of the National Constitution of The American Legion, **or who died subsequent to their honorable discharge from such service**, shall be eligible for membership in the Sons of The American Legion.

Join or Renew today! Questions on how to join? Come on in!

Consider becoming a Dual Member! Or Triple! If you are a Legion member and also qualify for Sons, then your Son's fees are only \$15 a year! What a deal! Why join **more than one** organization? Because it helps our bottom line—we all have different goals and missions to support American's Veterans and Military, and it also shows our department and national organizations when we report our membership numbers, volunteer hours, and community activities to Congress.

Firstly, a big **thank you** to all members of American Legion Post 364 for a successful membership year. Just a few notes and membership recap from July 1, 2025 to June 30, 2026:

- We met the goal set by District of 1,010 members (Currently at 1,012 members as of June 12)
- We welcomed 89 new members and 29 transfer members.
- Sadly, 16 members joined the Post Everlasting.

It is easy to renew: renew at the bar, by mail, or online (www.legion.org/renew). Online offers 3-year membership package—pay for 3 years at current registration fees. If online, you can print out a new card immediately; if renewing at the bar, the paper receipt is your proof of paying for membership until you receive your card.

Membership Dues for Post 364 are \$45 for the year. If you have served in federal active duty in the United States Armed Forces since December 7, 1941, and have been honorably discharged; or are still serving, you are eligible to join!

If online, you can print out a new card immediately; if renewing at the bar, the paper receipt is your proof of payment of membership until you receive your card. **Membership cards are located behind the bar. Please let me know if you need it mailed.**



Auxiliary's membership requirements also includes the male spouses of female Legionnaires. That's right - it is not "Ladies" Auxiliary—it is THE Auxiliary!

Starting July 1, 2026, the dues for year 2027 for Auxiliary Unit 364 are as follows:

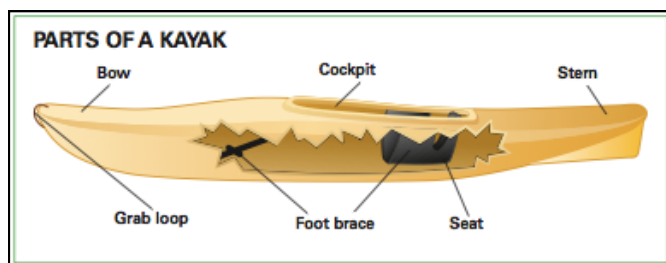

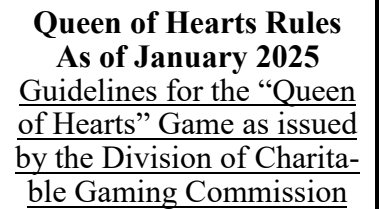

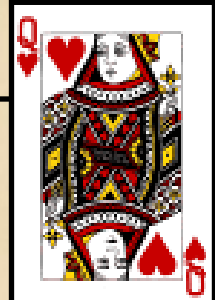
